<sup>17</sup>You shall not deprive a resident alien or an orphan of justice; you shall not take a widow's garment in pledge. <sup>18</sup>Remember that you were a slave in Egypt and the Lord your God redeemed you from there; therefore I command you to do this. <sup>19</sup>"When you reap your harvest in your field and forget a sheaf in the field, you shall not go back to get it; it shall be left for the alien, the orphan, and the widow, so that the Lord your God may bless you in all your undertakings. <sup>20</sup>When you beat your olive trees, do not strip what is left; it shall be for the alien, the orphan, and the widow. <sup>21</sup>When you gather the grapes of your vineyard, do not glean what is left; it shall be for the alien, the orphan, and the widow. <sup>22</sup>Remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt; therefore I am commanding you to do this.
